

HUBBARD FUND: SUBMISSION OF GRANTS, SCHOLARSHIPS, OR TUITION SUPPORT

GENERAL GRANT APPLICATION

The Hubbard Fund was “created to provide for ongoing monetary support for Catholic education in the greater Richmond, Indiana, community and to encourage others to make similar commitments.” The basic purpose of the Funds is to further Catholic education in the greater Richmond area. The following purposes are submitted as examples of appropriate distributions, bearing in mind, however, that as times change, needs change, and the committee members are not limited to these general distribution examples.

- a. Scholarships for worthy and/or needy Catholic students to further their Catholic education.
- b. Furtherance of the education of Catholic adults.
- c. Establishment and/or expansion of family centered Catholic education programs.
- d. Purchase of Catholic books and materials.
- e. Bringing to the Richmond Community outstanding Catholic speakers.
- f. Support of training programs for catechists in Catholic education.
